MSBA Fall Meeting

Trustees Jones, Sexsmith and Wadelius attended the Fall Manitoba School Boards Association Pd/General Meeting on November 22-23.

Among the topics presented were the dangers of vaping and meth use by students, general school safety concerns, and upcoming provincial legislation that may impact school divisions. Northern Region representatives unanimously adopted three resolutions proposed by KSD for the MSBA annual general meeting in March 2020. These resolutions advocated government support for travel costs for teachers to attend mandatory PD sessions in Winnipeg, advocated for better interactive TV options for such sessions, and a return to the access to dual credits for vocational course students.

An advertisement for the KSD superintendent position has been prepared and will go out in early December.

Wadelius Drive

The full engineering report for possible solutions to the drainage issues around Wadelius Drive and the SBMS bus turnaround is expected by the end of November. Subsequently KSD will meet with the Town to review the implications and costs. Unfortunately, until the release of the K-12 education review, the government has put a hold on all capital projects not yet approved, and has prohibited school divisions from setting aside funds for such projects.
