

Kelsey Learning Centre Administration

Formal education for adults in Kelsey School Division began with summer sessions, federally funded, developed with the support of MBCI administration, and operated out of temporary facilities at KCC. . In 1997 the program was formalized and operated out of Keewatin Community College, later renamed University College of the North. Initially these programs were under the administration of the MBCI principal, but in 2008 a separate building principal was named to oversee the school's program.
