

Education Minister Kelvin Goertzen announced that three non-instructional days taken from teachers at the beginning of the school year would be re-added to the 2020-21 school calendar. He identified that collaborative planning time is crucial as teachers coordinate new learning and delivery formats and deal with several issues related to teaching in a COVID-19 reality.

Two of these days will be scheduled before Christmas and one in the second semester. KSD was asked to incorporate these days into their calendars, where it fits best. In consultation with school leadership teams, the first two non-instructional days will be as follows:

Monday, November 30, 2020

Monday, December 7, 2020
