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About our School

The Kelsey Learning Centre (KLC) Literacy/Adult Learning Centre programs take the learner from where they are academically and personally, preparing them to earn a Province of Manitoba, Mature Student Highschool Diploma.

Alongside academic preparation, adults are exposed to micro-credentialing opportunities to help develop and strengthen their resumes for potential career pathway improvements or employment opportunities.

Mature Student Highschool Diploma Credit courses are classroom based, with delivery in smaller learner friendly classroom settings. Both synchronous daily attendance and asynchronous models are available to the individual learners, which are identified in their unique learning plans.



The staff of KLC create a non-threatening environment, built on atmosphere where it is safe for our learners to experience success. Kelsey Learning Centre is located inside of University College of the North's, The Pas Campus. Learners enjoy a post-secondary setting, with all the benefits of campus life while attending our programming. Community based supports are available through referrals from our office. Learners who have faced past negative educational experiences will develop self-confidence, self-esteem and a "can-do" attitude.

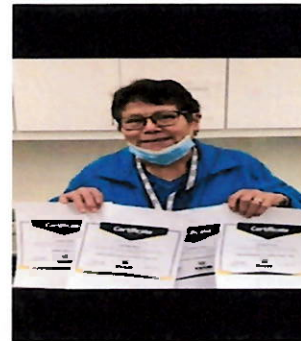

<p>Priority #1: Increase Enrollment, Retention & Student Attendance</p> <p>Our Indicators of Success: 5% Increase program wide registration and completion ratios.</p> <p>Our Strategies:</p> <p>Timely Sponsorship acquisition / Learning accountability agreements accepted and accessible to all learners who register with KLC.</p> <p>Flex Attendance policies to safely operate during COVID isolation periods, adapt the policy to reflect % of learner engagement in remote work, while maintaining academic rigor.</p> <p>Synergizing Partnerships for referral or direct services to overcome barriers to learner success. These community centered services help learners with financial, mental health, addictions services and family need. Many of these agency services do not operate office hours during COVID. Ie: Local Daycares, housing office, AFM, mental health, transportation, essential services, ability to connect to the internet.</p> <p>Motivation to attend regularly and strive for honors. Increase employability prospects, through digital and in-person mentorship.</p>	<p>Priority #2: Industry & Employment connections</p> <p>Our Indicators of Success: increase ratios of students receiving honors and exam exemptions by 5%</p> <p>Our Strategies:</p> <p>Provide tangible awards for success and participation.</p> <p>Continue exam exemptions based on core marks of 85% overall averages and higher, many learners reporting increased motivation to attend regularly and strive for honors.</p> <p>Maintain excellent attendance and achievement with tangible awards engagement Public Relations Large celebration on social media platforms.</p> <p>Micro credentials (at no cost to the learners) were used as rewards for perfect attenders. IE: January 17 & 18th, 2022 the Construction Safety Association of Manitoba partnered with KLC to offer two, one day (face to face delivery) courses offered to our perfect attenders, of the 12 successful attendance excellence recipients, all 12 earned their certification in fall protection, WHIMIS and transporting dangerous goods. These credentials are added to each learner's resume to help boost their employability prospects.</p> <p>Support adult students in career choices from KLC in on line post-secondary to UCN or other colleges in Manitoba.</p>
