



Cully Robinson Named Superintendent of Kelsey School Division

The Board of Trustees of Kelsey School Division is pleased to announce the appointment of Mr. Cully Robinson as Superintendent/CEO of the Kelsey School Division. The appointment was made at an August 23 Board meeting. The current Superintendent, Selena Mell, had accepted a position as Provincial Director of Education for the francophone School Board for Newfoundland and Labrador but agreed to stay up to the end of September to assist with the transferring of authority.

“The KSD Board sought a replacement with an extensive variety of senior management experiences and training,” noted Board Chair Vaughn Wadelius. “The Board was impressed with Robinson’s leadership experience with various education systems in New Brunswick, Alberta, British Columbia, Nunavut and Yukon.”

Originally from Niagara Falls, Ontario, Robinson is married with adult children. He has completed his Bachelor of Arts (Queen’s), Bachelor of Education (Windsor), Master of Education (Fraser) and is a doctoral student (Calgary).

Robinson believes that strong leadership is based on inclusion, support for indigenous students, and calm dialogue with school administrators and staff when dealing with issues. He also advocates student engagement and support, friendly connections to the community and media, and encouraging the personal growth and academic success of students and staff.

Robinson will assume the Superintendent/CEO position on September 6, 2022.
